**NEW: Collaborative Programming**

**DEADLINE: NOV 1, 2013**

- Purposes: promote collaboration across divisions and increase attendance at sessions
- 2-3 divs. must be involved; at least 2 participants (speakers); proposal submitted to primary division
- Can request 1-2 hours
- Process:
  - Submit proposal to primary division via the APA Website: <http://apacustomout.apa.org/ConvCall>
  - Division Program Chairs from all involved divisions select proposals to be reviewed by the Central Programming Group (CPG); if proposal is not selected, it will be retained by the primary division for consideration in Divisional Programming (see below)
  - If not accepted by the CPG, proposal will be returned to primary division for consideration in Divisional Programming

**Continuing Education Workshops**

**DEADLINE: NOV 11, 2013**

- Can request half day (4 hrs) or full day (7 hrs)
- Process:
  - Submit proposal to Continuing Education Committee (CEC)
  - CEC decides on acceptance and scheduling

**Divisional Programming**

**DEADLINE: DEC 2, 2013**

- Types of proposals: symposia, skill building sessions, conversation hours, posters
- NEW: Individual paper sessions will not be considered; research must be presented as symposia or posters
- Can request 1-2 hours
- Process:
  - Submit proposal to Division 47 via the APA Website: <http://apacustomout.apa.org/ConvCall>
  - All abstracts go through a blind review process
  - Program Chairs select final programming
